



QR CODE TEST PROCESS



1

Obtain the QR Code:

This could be a QR Code you created yourself or found online or in a printed document.

2

Get a QR Code Scanner App:

Many free scanner apps are available for download from the App Store or Google Play Store.

3

Scan the QR Code:

Open the scanner app on your device and point the camera at the QR Code. The app should automatically detect the code and display its content on your screen.

4

Check the Content:

Check the QR Code's content to ensure it's what you expected.

5

Test the Functionality:

If the QR Code triggers a specific action, such as downloading an app or making a payment, test the code's functionality.

6

Test the Readability:

If the QR Code is meant to be printed, test the readability of the code by printing it in different sizes and materials.

7

Verify the Authenticity:

If you are concerned about the authenticity of the QR Code, use a QR Code verification tool to check if the code is legitimate.

8

Test the Analytics:

If you are using QR Codes for marketing purposes, track the performance of the code using an analytics tool.
